**Bonus of \$5 per entry; maximum \$50 per exhibitor will be paid in Cattle Classes**

**Membership pass allows exhibitor and one helper admittance to the grounds**

## **Rules:**

If, in the opinion of the Directors, enough animals of one breed that is not listed show in the Other Beef Breeds class, then they may be assigned their own class.

1. Beef Cattle show under regulations of Federal Livestock Classifications.
2. Each exhibitor allowed maximum of 10 entries excluding Breeder's Herd.
3. Each exhibitor may show 2 entries per section.

All 4-H members must follow the 4-H dress code. Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>: \$30; 2<sup>nd</sup>: \$25; 3<sup>rd</sup>: \$20; 4<sup>th</sup>: \$15

1. Exhibitor must be 9-11 years of age
2. Exhibitor must be between the ages of 12-15 years
3. Exhibitor must be 16-21 years of age.

**Cattle Classes**

Judging to begin at 11 a.m.

Prize Money Schedule for each Cattle Class as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> \$60; 2<sup>nd</sup> \$55; 3<sup>rd</sup> \$45; 4<sup>th</sup> \$35; 5<sup>th</sup> \$30; 6<sup>th</sup> \$25; 7<sup>th</sup> \$20; 8<sup>th</sup> \$17

1. Bull calf, born on or after January 1, 2017, minimum of six months of age on day of judging.
2. Bull yearling, born April 1, 2016 – December 31, 2016.
3. Bull yearling, born January 1, 2016 – March 31, 2016.
4. Bull, born January 1, 2014 – December 31, 2016
5. Female calf, born on or after January 1, 2017, minimum of six months of age on day of judging.
6. Heifer, born April 1, 2016 – December 31, 2016.
7. Heifer, born January 1, 2016 – March 31, 2016.
8. Female, born January 1, 2015 – December 31, 2015 with her own 2017 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot (must be shown as a unit).
9. Female, born prior to January 1, 2015 with her own 2017 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot (must be shown as a unit).
10. Breeder's Herd. A group of 4 animals, bred by exhibitor, both sexes represented, must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal owned by exhibitor. One entry per exhibitor.
